

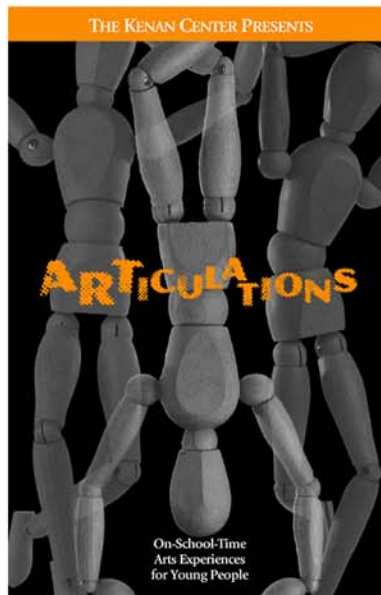

Brochure interior beyond the gatefold.

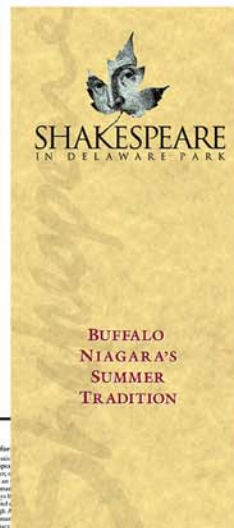
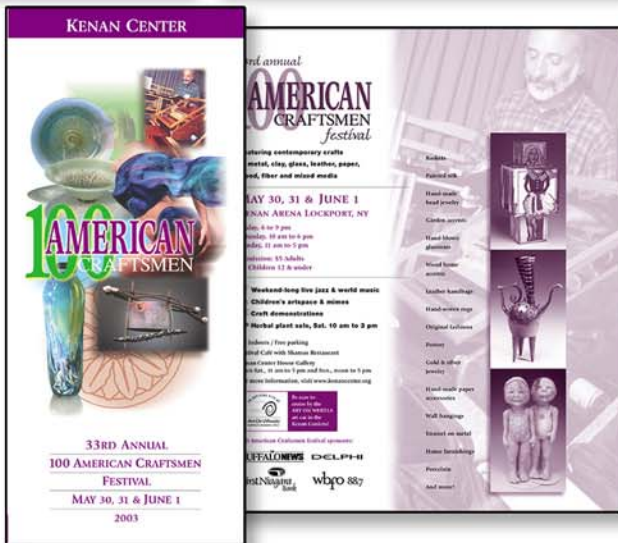


Cover for a 12 page booklet describing a Kenan Center Arts and Education program.

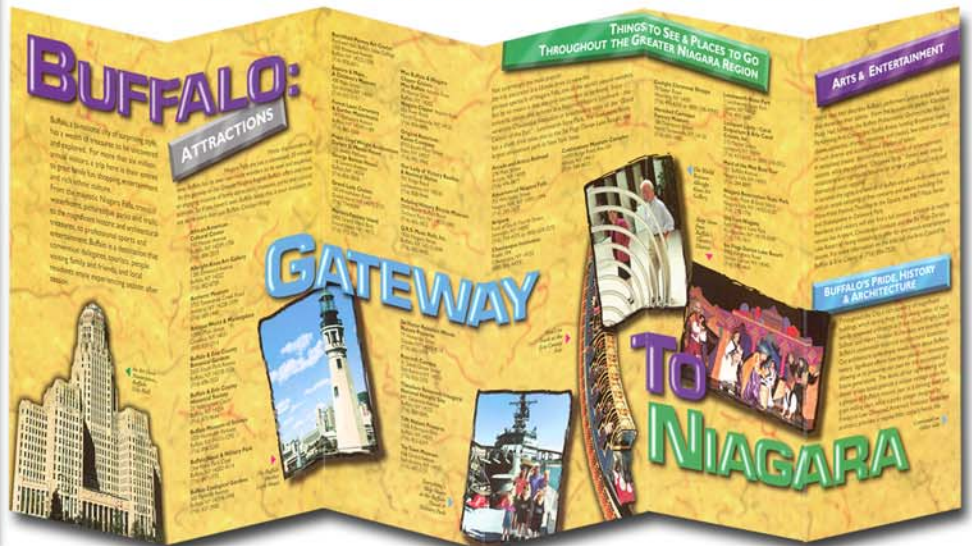
